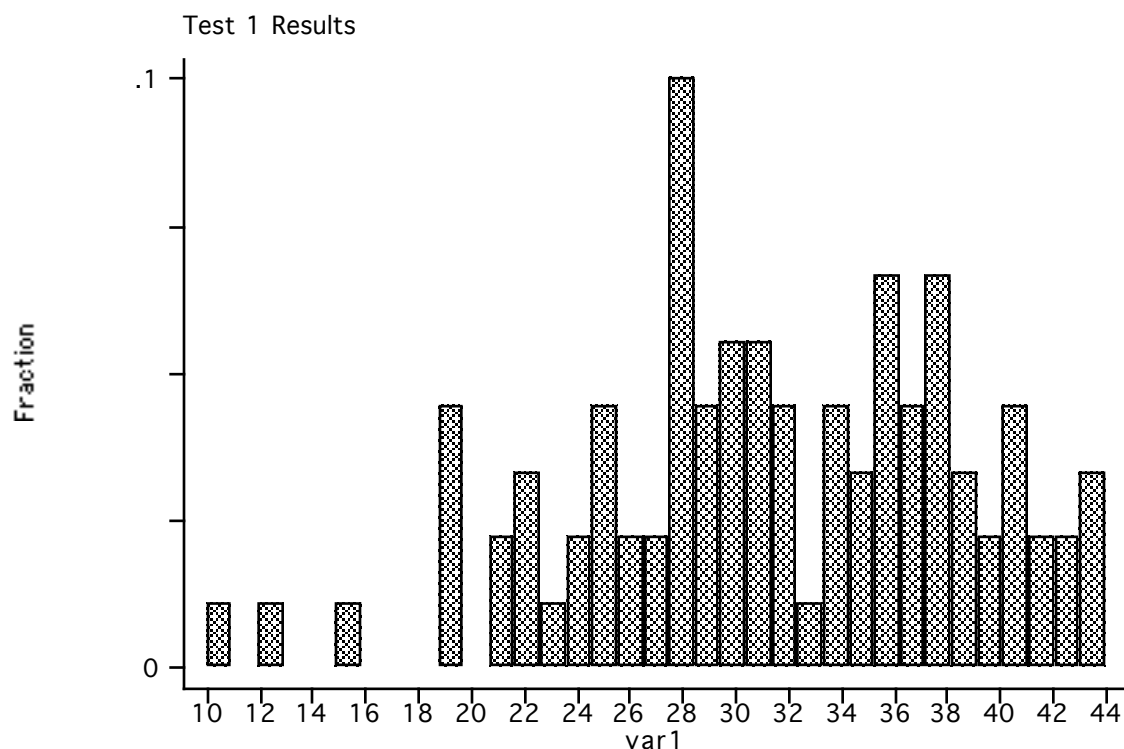


## Results

Mean 32.7 Standard Deviation = 6.2

Median 32 75<sup>th</sup> Percentile 38, 25<sup>th</sup> Percentile 28

Maximum 44 (3) Minimum 10 (1)



There were 3 forms. There were no meaningful differences in the average scores between forms. On this test, these are approximate breakdowns since discussions of exact grades are meaningless at this time:

44-37 "A" grade there were 32

36-28 "B" grade there were 35

27-20 "C" grade there were 16

below 20 is not passing at this time,
