Poll: Bay Area Convinced by Powell's Argument

An exclusive Eyewitness News poll showed more than half of those surveyed in the Bay Area were convinced by Secretary of State Colin Powell (news - web sites)'s case for war against Iraq.



Powell laid out the Bush administration's argument to the United Nations (news - web sites) Wednesday, using newly declassified information. He said the evidence proved that leaving weapons of mass destruction in the hands of Saddam Hussein (news - web sites) was not an option.

The Survey USA poll reached 257 Bay Area residents who heard Powell's speech. Fifty-one percent were convinced by the case for military action, while 39% said Powell failed to sway them. The remainder were undecided. The poll had a margin of error of just over 6%.
