Bush, Kerry in Tight Race With Just One Day to Go

With only one day until the election, most of the latest polls show President Bush and Sen. John Kerry within one or two points of each other. In polls where the candidates aren't running exactly even, it's the president holding the upper hand.

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A new Harris Interactive telephone poll¹ released around midday shows Mr. Bush ahead by four percentage points in a telephone survey of likely voters, but the outcome is reversed in Harris's new online poll, which has Mr. Kerry leading by two points.

The president has a small lead in four polls taken over the weekend by Reuters/Zogby, Rasmussen Reports, The Wall Street Journal and NBC News, and Gallup for CNN and USA Today.

Mr. Bush has a slightly larger lead in polls from CBS News/New York Times, Pew Research Center and Newsweek. He is tied with Mr. Kerry in three recent polls from Fox News, American Research Group and ABC News/Washington Post.
