We seek outstanding candidates working broadly in causal machine learning, including but not limited to the following areas:

1. Causal discovery, causal inference, graphical models, and structure learning
2. Sequential decision-making and interventions in dynamic causal systems
3. Causal representation learning
4. Applications of these methods to computational genomics

Applicants must hold a Ph.D. in Statistics, Biostatistics, Computer Science, or a related field by the start date of the appointment.

The application should include the following attachments:

1. A cover letter describing the applicant's research interests and how they align with the position

Subject to departmental approval, the selected candidate may have the opportunity to teach courses through a split appointment between the postdoctoral position and an Adjunct Assistant Professor position.
